## *Anticipated Itinerary*

- Sat May 29 Our journey as Women of the Word begins with a trans-Atlantic flight to Amsterdam from Chicago.

## *Carrie Burns*

Carrie Burns loves God's Word, His Son, His Land and His people. She's at home behind a microphone, broadcasting since 1996 on Great News Radio in east-central Illinois and speaking to groups across the US about the things of God she loves so dearly. With a teacher's heart (she has a doctorate in Education), she has organized pilgrimages and humanitarian trips to Israel since 1999. Ten years after her first trip to the Holy Land, she was selected to receive a full scholarship with the International School for Holocaust Educators at Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Museum in Jerusalem. This experience opened the doors for her to conduct seminars on Judeo-Christian relations and antisemitism in churches across America on behalf of the International Christian Embassy in Jerusalem. Susie Sandager of Albuquerque, New Mexico and Carrie Burns met in Jerusalem in January 2009 while attending the 3-week seminar for Holocaust educators. Like Carrie, Susie Sandager loves the land, people, faith, and history of Israel and had received a similar scholarship to study at Yad VaShem. Susie is also at home behind a microphone. The unique call on her life is to give voice to the legacy of Corrie ten Boom, the beloved Dutch Christian who rescued hundreds of Dutch Jews during WWII. Susie as "Corrie" has received accolades from around the world for her soul-stirring performances and together with her Attorney/Pastor husband John has been honored by Israel Bonds, The Anti-Defamation League, Hadassah, and the Jewish Federation of Greater Albuquerque. In 2008 they received a New Mexico Humanitarian Award for Yad B'Yad (Hebrew for Hand-in-Hand) for their efforts to encourage understanding and friendship between Christians and Jews for the times in which we live.
